### **Where do I meet for the Guest Tours?**

# Guest Activities

**Saturday, September 20, 2008**

**Tour #1 - Come Fly with Me - Dayton OH**  
**8:00 am to 5:00 pm, \$90**

Walk in the footsteps of true pioneers. From the Wright Brothers to modern day aviation, southwestern Ohio is home to flight. Your first stop will be with the humble beginnings of the Wright Brothers at their airfield. See The Wright B Flyer, a reproduction of the Wright Brother's Model B Military Flyer and explore the early days of their quest for human flight. Attendees will then continue on to The National Museum of The United States Air Force. This magnificent museum showcases every element of military flight from the early days through the space program. An extra special element of this tour is a visit to the Presidential and Research and Development Test Flight Galleries located on Wright Patterson Air Force Base. Note: For access to the Presidential and Research & Development Flight Test Galleries, a current government-issued photo ID (driver's license) is required for visitors over age 18. Foreign visitors must present an original passport.
